

I do have a few questions regarding the project:

1. The design is unclear — it's difficult to determine what exactly should be displayed and where. Some elements appear to be shown, others not. Even similar pages don't provide full clarity (e.g., should the price be displayed, are cards with information needed, which buttons should be shown, etc.). **See screenshot below of draft listing page. From the thumbnails, lake size and nearest ferry port should always appear. Carp size and accommodation sleeps should only appear if populated in admin.**

From the tabs 'overview', 'ferry ports' and 'map' should always appear. 'Fish stock' and 'facilities' should appear when populated.

Price is as displayed with the option in admin to be £ or Euros

There is one button which is 'message seller'. When this is clicked the enquiry form should appear.

2. There's no design for the seller profile — which exact fields and layout should appear under the relevant tabs?

Seller profile should look very similar to the current profiles we have. I have drafted the fields that need to appear. Below screenshot is optimised for desktop. Mobile optimisation should be same design as current profiles are for lake owners.

3. You mentioned using the same fields as for “lake” listings — will these fields be subject to future changes (e.g., fields being added or removed)? This impacts implementation and the logic we build.

I would like to have the flexibility so in the future we can add or remove fields.

4. How is a seller account created? We will need to create them in admin under ‘add user’ <https://dreamcarpholidays.com/wp-admin/user-new.php>

We will need to create a new role profile for ‘lake sellers’ as their account will not have the same information as the users who hire lakes out

5. How is a seller linked to a “lake for sale” item?

We need to replicate the ‘lakes’ section in admin which is here

The new section which will need to be under the heading ‘lakes for sale’ in admin

As we currently do for adding a new lake in admin, under the heading ‘lake owner and other setting’ the lake seller will be linked to the lake for sale. Screenshot below:

6. For regular “lake” listings, there’s a section to enter the seller’s email and Stripe-related data — is something similar needed here? If yes, how should it work?

The sellers email address will be captured when a new user is created and role assigned.
The Stripe field is not required

7. If we introduce a new seller role, will the existing functionality need to be adjusted accordingly? Since seller ≠ buyer, their access scopes and available pages may differ.

SO the lakes for sale will be a completely new section of the website and needs to be separate from the current lake listings. A lot of the functionality will be the same as the current lake listings pages. See the attached designs as i think this will help

8. If an email is sent when a seller replies to an enquiry, does that mean an account with the “customer” role must be created when the form is submitted?


An account does not need to be created in when a visitor to the website sends an enquiry. In the same way the website currently works when an enquiry is submitted, when the seller replies the email will contain a url which will display the reply message and enable to the customer and lake seller to exchange messages

9. What happens if the email is already registered with a different role (e.g., another seller)?

If the email address already belongs to an existing user and the role profile of that user is not a seller then a different email address will need to be used. A seller can have more than one lake for sale however. This will work in the same way the website currently works where a lake owner can lost more than one lake.

10. Should enquiries appear in the existing list of booking requests, or will a separate menu item be created for them? This affects how we implement the feature.
